Enjoy the downtown skyline from this popular spot. Paddleboard, kayak, canoe or sail. The rental options are endless and affordable.

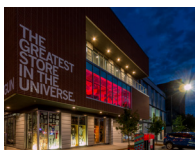


JOHN & MARY PAPPAGJOHN SCULPTURE PARK:
